## **Scholarship Name:**

North Star is a one scholarship fund with two award cycles

- 1. The North Star Turkish Scholarship of Dallas Fall & Spring
- 2. The North Star Turkish Scholarship of Dallas Spring Only

# Which one to apply:

Students can apply only 1 option per scholarship cycle.

- Fall & Spring scholarship cycle opens March 1: Recipients are awarded \$500 for Fall 2023; \$500 for Spring 2024. This scholarship is for students who will be enrolled for both semesters either as a full time student or part-time student (partial credit). Recipients of this scholarship cannot apply for Spring scholarship below.
- Spring scholarship cycle opens August 1 This is for transfering students.
  \$1,000 for Spring 2024 (recipients of the Fall \$500 & Spring \$500 are not eligible for this one).

#### **Deadlines:**

1. Fall Scholarship Application Timeline (approximate):

3/01/23 - 6/01/23 Applications accepted

6/22/23 – 7/06/23 Applications reviewed by committee

7/20/23 - Applicants notified

7/27/23 - Recipients must agree to accept award

#### 2. Spring Scholarship Application Timeline (approximate):

8/01/23 - 11/01/23 Applications accepted

11/7/23 – 7/21/23 Applications reviewed by committee

12/5/23 – Applicants notified

12/12/23 – Recipients must agree to accept award

#### **Scholarship Frequency:**

- 1. Semester Renewal [recipients in Fall will receive in Spring if they still meet original criteria.]
- 2. Annual One Time/One Semester [recipients of Fall & Spring award are ineligible.]

#### How to apply:

To apply for Dallas College Foundation scholarships, students must have the following:

- Completed a Dallas College Admissions Application -or- must be enrolled as a current Dallas College student.

   If you are already a Dallas College student, follow the steps below.
- Be enrolled in classes by the scholarship deadline to qualify for scholarships with enrolled hours requirement.

**How To Submit an Application** 

### 1. SIGN IN TO MYSCHOLARSHIPS

- Enter your Dallas College ID example: e9876543@student.dcccd.edu
- Enter your Dallas College password
- If you have trouble logging in, select Trouble Signing In

#### 2. Complete and submit the General Application.

You will be automatically matched with our scholarships that you qualify for, based on the information you provide on your application and from your Dallas College record.

Make sure you keep your contact information, Program of Study and major up to date with Dallas College. Contact the <u>Admissions/Registrar's Office</u> to update your information.

**3. Some scholarships require additional information** such as supplemental questions, essays, or recommendations/verifications.

To see these scholarships, select the **Opportunities** tab. To apply for these scholarships, click on the **Apply** button next to the scholarship name and complete the application. If you do not complete the entire application, you may select **Save and Keep Editing** and return later to finish your application. Once complete, select **Finish and Submit**.

4. Frequently check the status of your applications.

Select the **My Application** tab to view your applications, to review scholarships you have accepted, or finish ones that need attention.

5. Check the status of your recommendation/verification requests.

Select the **References** tab to view all recommendation/verification requests.

If selected to receive a scholarship you will be notified by email. You will have seven (7) days from the date you receive the email to accept the scholarship and to complete the post-acceptance questions. If you accept a scholarship, it does not affect your financial aid status.

Scholarship awards will be placed on your eConnect account the week prior to the first day of class. If your account is paid in full, you will receive a refund after the 12th day of classes when the Financial Aid Offices processes refunds.
